

Peter and Ann Parsons' Travels on Soviet Motorcycles.

Extracted from Avtoexport Roundup 1984

The journal covered the journeys of the English couple on three long overland trips during the late 1970s and the early 1980s. They used basically standard machines and suffered very few problems. We reproduce here the routes and the photos. After their trips their bikes were sold on into other useful work.

1. Ural M66, 9000 km. London – France – Spain – Morocco – Algeria – Niger - Nigeria – Upper Volta – Ghana – Togo – Benin – Cameroon.
2. Dnieper MT9, 11000 km. London – France – Senegal – Mali – Upper Volta – Ghana – Upper Volta – Cameroon – Central African Republic – Zaire – Tanzania – Kenya.
3. Dnieper MT12, 19000 km. Australia – Singapore – Malaysia – India – Nepal - India.
