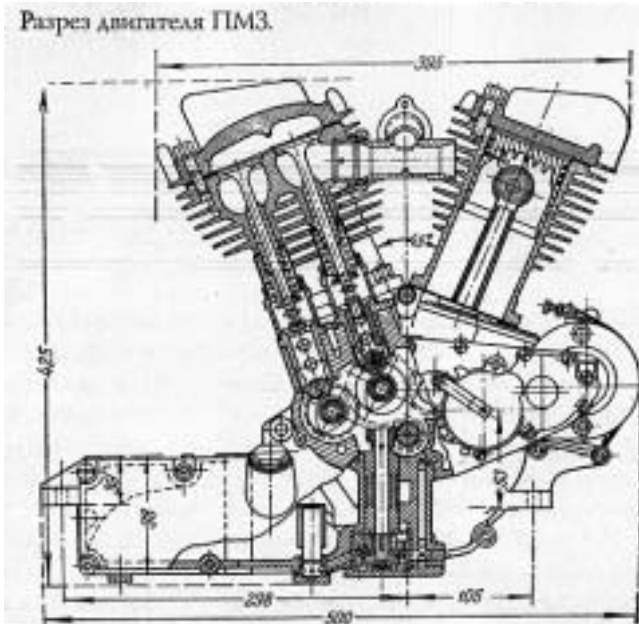


PMZ – Podolsk Machinery Zavod - Russia



1930s - this wonderful 750cc 'Vee Twin' side-valve machine was produced for 2 years only. Believed to be of solely Russian design – but inevitably there will be influences from others. The huge enamel badges are the same as found on “Podolsk” sewing machines - a free tip for PMZ restorers around the world. The PMZ was more affectionately deciphered as Poprobuy Menya Zavdy – “Try to Start Me!” because of its notorious poor cold starting abilities. (Interestingly the early FIAT cars used to be famous for Fiat’s early slogan – Fires In All Temperatures!)
